What is involved in being in a partial denture study

- You attend visits at the Oral Health Research Institute on the IUPUI campus
- You test dental products
- Your lower partial denture holds two tooth chips that can be removed and studied in the lab
- Persons who wear a lower partial denture will be paid \$25 cash for attending a screening visit, whether they qualify or not.
- Once qualified, persons participating in future lower partial denture studies can be paid \$200-\$600 per study and receive free dental cleanings.
