Direct Loans Graduate PLUS Loan	Cost of Attendance (COA) minus other aid (no lifetime aggregate limit)	Fixed Rate-7.9% & 4.204% fee; credit-based loan
Private student loan	Cost of Attendance (COA) minus other aid	Variable & fixed rate options; credit approval required. Co-signer may also be required.
